Re: Conflict Minerals

To Our Valued Customers:

Leviton is committed to the responsible sourcing of materials in our products, as well as supporting our customers where feasible and commercially reasonable.

The Dodd-Frank Act and the SEC final rules implementing this law have brought the issue of Conflict Minerals to the forefront of many corporate agendas. Although the law does not require Leviton or its customers of Leviton stock items, private or reporting entities, to make any Conflict Minerals report concerning these Leviton stock items, we recognize that a growing number of our customers have voluntarily adopted a commitment that is broader than the law mandates.

To this end Leviton has been and is continuing to take reasonable steps to trace the country of origin of relevant metals through its supply chain and respond to our customers' inquiries, as best as possible.

We ask our customers to recognize Leviton's efforts and to consider that Leviton is exerting its best efforts to meet its customers' social responsibility programs while minimizing the additional cost that this effort introduces into our products.

Leviton requires all of our suppliers to provide us with complete conflict minerals declarations using the CMRT (Conflict Minerals Reporting Template). We may reconsider our willingness to partner with suppliers that fail to comply with this policy.
