

LRQA Independent Assurance Statement

Relating to Leviton Manufacturing UK Ltd compliance to PAS 510:2021.

This Assurance Statement has been prepared for Leviton Manufacturing UK Ltd in accordance with our contract.

Terms of Engagement

LRQA was commissioned by Leviton Manufacturing UK Ltd to provide independent assurance on its compliance with the requirements of PAS 510:2021 against the assurance criteria below to a reasonable level of assurance and the materiality of the professional judgement of the verifier using LRQA's verification procedure. LRQA's verification procedure is based on current best practise and is in accordance with ISAE 3000 and ISAE 3410.

Our assurance engagement covered Leviton Manufacturing UK Ltd's operations and activities at the Glenrothes, UK sites, and specifically the following requirements:

- Verifying conformance with:
 - PAS 510:2021 Plastic pellets, flakes and powders Handling and management throughout the supply chain to prevent their leakage to the environment.

Our assurance engagement excluded the data and information of Leviton Manufacturing UK Ltd's suppliers, contractors and any third-parties mentioned in the reports.

LRQA's responsibility is only to Leviton Manufacturing UK Ltd. LRQA disclaims any liability or responsibility to others as explained in the end footnote. Leviton Manufacturing UK Ltd's responsibility is for developing a plastic pellet management system and for presenting information on performance related to that management system. Ultimately, the management system has been approved by, and remains the responsibility of Leviton Manufacturing UK Ltd.

LRQA's Opinion

Observations

Further observations and findings, made during the assurance engagement, are:

• It would be beneficial to consider additional controls e.g. bunding, around the storage silos to reduce the risks of plastic pellets entering the environment.
